Thursday Sept the 20<sup>th</sup> 1849  
Strong winds from the Eastward  
33.10 164.4

Friday the 21<sup>st</sup>  
Moderate Breezes from the S E  
Steering S E. 1/2 S. Back  
and Squid 32.15 165.30

Saturday the 22<sup>nd</sup>  
light S winds and Calm  
Steering N E. Saw Squid  
Employed in cleaning the  
windlass, rigging, and putting  
new Seaman Ropes to the main  
top sail  
Sun 156.16  
Lat 32.10 Lon 156.00

Sunday the 23<sup>rd</sup>  
light air from the westward  
Steering N N E

Monday the 24<sup>th</sup>  
Calm  
Lat 32.10

Tuesday the 25<sup>th</sup>  
first part "light air"  
from the westward  
Steering S E at 9 P.M.  
We hauled to the S W and  
gave ship to the S W and  
steering N with a fine breeze  
at 12 M. It wore to the S E

Wednesday the 26<sup>th</sup>  
first part "fine" Breezes  
from the S W steering  
to the S E

On the Japan Ground  
Thursday the 27<sup>th</sup> of Sept 1849  
Strong winds from the  
Westward steering to the  
Southward

Friday the 28<sup>th</sup>  
Strong from the westward  
steering to the Eastward.  
Lat. at start light and  
baffling with a number  
of water spouts near  
by. Employed in Breasting  
out the S side of the  
Fore hold for water and  
preparing to draw oil  
170.00 30.20

Saturday the 29<sup>th</sup>  
fine weather Employed in  
spawning down oil we found  
the water tank which we  
have had water in since we  
left home badly decayed

Sunday the 30<sup>th</sup>  
light air from the Southward  
Steering N E to Employed  
in stowing oil at 5 P.M.  
finished

Monday Oct. the 1<sup>st</sup>  
fine weather the wind from  
the westward

Tuesday the  
Moderate wind from the westward  
steering to the Eastward
