Saturday the 6th
Strong winds from the Eastward
Steering by to the Northward
the Baby still worse the Complaint
seems to assume the appearance of
Dysentary

Sunday the 7th
First part Strong winds from
Eastward latter part light
winds from the Sea

Monday the 8th
First part light winds
from the S.W. Steering E.N.E.
at 3 A.M. the hauld
to the Northward and commenced
Raining at 5 took in the Fore
and Mizzen top Sails

On Japan

Tuesday the 9th of Oct 1849
First part Strong Gale and
Raining from the Northward
Under Close Reefed main top Sails
latter part Strong winds but
Clear the Child very Sick
Lat 28:30 178:14

Wednesday the 10th
Strong winds from the N.E. Steering
by to the Eastward at 6 P.M. set
sea watches for a Passage in to
the Sandwich Islands the Child is
very Sick and weak but Lat 27:40 179:40
the most patient that I ever saw

Thursday the 11th
Strong winds from the N.E.
Steering by to the Eastward under
Close Reefed top Sails at 4 P.M.
wore to the N.W. Employed taring
and Battling Down
the Child no better the poor thing
is very weak we have nothing
to do with Mrs Young is very Anxious
and if she is Sick I do not know
what the Child will do.

Friday the 12th
Strong winds from the S.E. at 3
P.M. wore ship to the Eastward
latter part it blew on Strong
took in the jib and main Sails
and Close Reefed the top Sails
Mrs Young very Sick with same
Complaint that the Child has. the
Child is some better or more
comfortable it is my greatest wish
that they will both recover soon
