Friday Oct. the 19<sup>th</sup> 1849  
first part light winds  
from the N<sup>W</sup> Steering E N E  
Latter part the raised hauled  
to the S<sup>W</sup> Employed in Repairing  
Sails Mrs Young is on the  
Mending hawl but very slow  
She is deprived of her rest  
So much night that it would  
bear out of a well person much  
more a sick one the child  
is not as well as she was  
yesterday

Saturday the 20<sup>th</sup> Lat 30:45 Long 165:14  
Moderate Breezes from the  
S<sup>W</sup> Steering E N E  
Employed Repairing Sails and  
Old Cooper pipes Mrs Young  
and Child still on  
gaining hand and I hope  
to see them both well in  
a few days

Sunday the 21<sup>st</sup> Lat 30:51 Long 167:24  
first part fine Breezes from  
the S<sup>W</sup> Steering E N E  
at 4 P M the wind hauled  
to the Northward and set in thick  
at 9 P M it blew so strong  
that we had to close reef the  
top Sails and furl the fore and  
main Sails latter part  
more moderate the wind S E  
Steering by to the E S E under  
Double Reefed top Sails

Mrs Young is much better  
and I am truly glad the  
child improves slowly Lat 30:10

The Sandwich Islands

Monday Oct. the 22<sup>d</sup> 1849  
first part strong winds and squally  
weather the wind from the N E Steering  
by to the E S E under Double  
Reefed top Sails latter part  
the same Mrs Young and Bill  
improving in health Lat 29:15 Long 165:14

Tuesday the 23<sup>d</sup>  
first part strong winds from  
the N E Steering by to the N N W  
under Double Reefed top Sails  
at 3 P M Mrs Young came on  
Deck for a few minutes for  
the first time since she was  
taken sick latter part light  
winds Steering the same going  
and Baby was on Deck for  
2 hours it was good for some  
eyes to see him  
Broke out for mottles Lat 30:55 Long 164:56  
and Bent a new main sail

Wednesday the 24<sup>th</sup>  
first part calm Employed in Repairing  
the old main sail at 8 P M a  
sprang up from the fore hatch  
latter part fine Breezes from  
the S Steering E N E Employed  
Shaping to it for and taking up the  
old cables to Repair  
Mrs Young improves in health slowly but the child  
is not at all well to day I hope for  
the mother sake that we shall get  
in soon to get some Relief Lat 30:44 Long 163:07
