for some Days

Sunday Oct. the 28th 1849
first part fine Breezes from the
Southered Steering by to the
Eastward at 4 PM she came
up S by E at 12 M she hauled
to the Southered Steering S by E
at 8 AM Raised a sail
& Point off the S. Bow Steering
to the Southered Mrs Young
is unwell she says that she
thinks that she has the
Scoury coming on the Baby is
about the same

Monday the 29th
first part Strong winds from
the Southered Steering S by E & E
Later part it hauled to N & E
Steering S by E Employed washing
the Paint work Mrs Young
is much the same not Sick
ahead but unwell the Baby
is gaining slowly

Tuesday the 30th
Strong trades first part Steering
S by E Later part Steering
S by E & E Employed making new
Borst Back Stays for the main
top gallant mast Mrs Young
quite smart the Baby is gaining
slowly and I hope that she will
soon get smart when we get in

Wednesday the 31st
Strong trades and Squally Steering
S by E Later part Under Double
Reefed top sail Steering S by E
the Baby not as well as she has been
