Tuesday the 29th of Jan 1850
fine weather steering
S. by E

Wednesday the 30th
fine weather the wind
from the S. E. steering N. W.

Thursday the 31st
fine weather fresh
trades at 9 AM raised
a sail at 11

Friday the 1st of Feb
strong trades at 3 PM
the ship came down and
I spoke it it proved to be
the Herald of Fair Haven
she had taken 500 bls
of oil the last 10 days
the Capt came on board
at 8 AM we lowered
the 3rd boat and went on
board of her and got
2nd boat load of wood
and 4 bls of bark
and let her a cask of bread
I sold her my Decrdrant
for \$16.00

Saturday the 2nd
first part strong trades
steering by S. by E
the Herald still in sight

Sunday the 3rd
strong trades steering by S. by E
the Herald & Bark Belle in
sight

On the Sea & Ground

Monday Feb the 4th 1850
first light trades steering S by
E the Bark & the Herald
hamming of the weather Breeze
at 6 3/4 PM struck a porpoise
but lost him

Tuesday the 5th
fine weather steering S. W.

Wednesday the 6th
fine weather the wind S. E.
steering S. W. by E

Thursday the 7th
fine trades steering S. W.
saw a large body of Fin
Bark

Friday the 8th
first part fine weather spoke
the ship Barkly and Elizabeth
1100 bls of Sp Oil 350 of whale
Barkly 800 of Sp Oil

Saturday the 9th
strong trades steering by for
Whales

Sunday the 10th
strong trades steering by
to the Southward
at 8 PM passed the Elizabeth
at 9 raised Ocean Island

Monday the 11th
fine weather
