

Ship Abigail towards

Saturday the 23rd of Feb 1850

At 10 A.M. raised the Strong Island
Bearing N.E. by E Dist 40 miles

at 2 P.M. backed ship to
the Eastward at 12 M. the
Island Bearing E. by E Dist
8 miles

Monday the 25th
fine weather at 2 P.M.
backed to the Northward
at 12 M. the Island
Bearing N.W. by W Dist 30 miles

Tuesday the 26th
fine weather at 6 P.M. the
Dist 12 miles Bearing N.W. by W
and backed to the Eastward
at 2 P.M. to the Northward
at 12 M. the Island Bearing S.W. Dist
15 miles Steering N.W.

Wednesday the 27th
Strong trades and squally
first part steering N.W.
latter part steering W. & N.W.

Thursday the 28th
first part squally steering W.
at 6 P.M. shortened sail
and steered to by N.
latter part clear

The Lagoon Islands

Friday Feb the 28th 1850

first part strong winds and
squally steering to by S. at 3 P.M.
raised Wellington Island

Wellington Island

Bearing S.E. by S Dist 5 1/2 miles

Bearing N.E. by E Dist 40 miles
at bearing S Dist 30 miles
at 5 P.M. there was a canoe
came off with a white man in it
we shot 1 Green Turtle
at 4 put away for attention to S.W.
all of the latter part raining

Saturday the 2nd

Strong winds and squally at 6 P.M.
shortened sail and luffed too
at daylight put her off to and
saw the land well then near
enough to see 2 ships going off and on
and then luffed to the wind
on the S back to the N.W.

Sunday the 3rd
Strong trades but clear steering
to the Northward to go clear of Island
and shoals at 5 P.M. put her off
N.W. this killed the turtle
