

Ship Abigail lying at Quam

Monday the 17th 1850
fine weather the Schoach
went ashore for 3 more days

Tuesday the 18th
Employed Blacking Bends &c

Wednesday the 19th
finished getting wood having
got off 12 Chores at 7th
Noah Returned to the Ship

Thursday the 20th
fine the Schoach went
on shore for liberty

Friday the 21st
Strong trades and Squally
at 5 P.M. sent the Fore Mast
Mast & jib boom

Saturday the 22nd
Strong trades Employed
Shaping water and cleaning
the Fore Mast
at 5 P.M. sent the Boat
in for the Schoach but none
came off to day Discharged the Cook

Sunday the 23rd
at 7 A.M. sent the Boat
for the Schoach they all came
off but 23 Drubok

Monday the 24th
sent the Green top Sack
& 1000 lbs Sack and
got the last of our Reddicks

Tuesday the 25th of March 1850
fine weather but a very heavy
swell in the Harbour at 1 P.M.
On Capt Young and Lady came
on Board at 6 P.M. went on
shore for the goat

Wednesday the 26th
at 6 A.M. made up our anchor
and went to sea

Thursday the 27th
Strong trades and Squally at
4 P.M. made up our anchor
and sold for a blubber black
latter part moderate then
other still in sight at 11:18

Friday the 28th
first fine the other ship in sight
latter part Squally

Saturday the 29th
Strong trades and Squally weather
steering by to the Northward (2 sails in
sight to windward)

Sunday the 30th
Strong trades steering by to the Northward
at 1 P.M. 1850 11:30

Monday the 31st
Strong trades steering by to the
Northward latter employed Reddicks
a main top sail for a fore

Tuesday the 1st of April 1850
Strong trades from the E & S
steering by to Northward under
close of Reefed top sails at 5 A.M.
killed the Bullock
