More moderate Employed  
Repairing jib & fore sail  
and bending them 3/40 155-12  
Steering by to the N E

Sunday the 28th  
Light winds from the N E  
Steering by to the Northward  
N E  
Lat 32-53 155-22

Monday the 29th  
Light winds from the Eastward  
Steering by to the N E  
at 6 P.M. set the boat  
for the N W Coast Lat  
part & broke out steps for the  
men

Tuesday the 30th  
Moderate breezes from the E S E  
Steering N E some fog  
Employed making side  
clothes 35-58 156-30

Wednesday the 1st of May 1850  
Moderate breezes from the S E  
and foggy Employed fitting  
the jib & fore sail and also  
the main sail & bent the jib

Thursday May the 2nd 1850  
first part calm and foggy  
few Breeze Backs and  
Porpoises

Friday the 3rd  
Moderate breezes from the S E  
Steering N E by N

Saturday the 4th  
first part Moderate breezes  
and foggy from the Southward  
at 2 3/4 P.M. the vessel  
heaved to the N W and blew  
heavy close Reefed topsails  
Steering N N E

Sunday the 5th  
Strong gale from the N W at  
2 1/4 P.M. took in the fore  
sail

Monday the 6th  
first part blowing a  
Gale from the N W latter  
part moderate Steering  
by to the N W the vessel  
N N E

Tuesday the 7th  
Moderate breezes from the North  
Steering by to the N W
