Monday June 3^d
Fine Weather and light
Breezes from the Southward
Steering by to the S E

Tuesday June 4th
Light winds from the South
Steering by to the S E
Set Boats crew watches and
sent aloft the 3^d & Mizzen top gallant
yards masts Lat 3535

Wednesday June 5th
Moderate Breezes from the
S S E Steering by to the S W
Sent up the 7th jib boom

Thursday June 6th
Moderate Breezes from the S E
with a smoky atmosphere
employed setting the main top
gallant braces blocks and pennants
and sent the old fore sail

Friday June 7th
Spry winds and foggy from
the S to Steering W by S to the
S E sent up the Mizzen
top gallant yard Lat 3428

Saturday June 8th 1850
Spry Breezes from the Westward
Steering by to the Southward
Started water
Sunday June 9th
Moderate Breezes from the Northward
Steering S by W

Monday June 10th
First part light Breezes from
the Northward Steering W
Latter part Calm & employed
in sending up the fore top gallant
yard and Repairing the old
Mizzen top sail Lat 3444 168

Tuesday June 11th
Moderate Breezes from the Southward
Steering W by S & employed Repairing
the Mizzen top sail

Wednesday June 12th
First fresh Breezes from the
S to Steering by the wind
& to be to some squally at
4 P.M. finished and Rept the
Mizzen top sail and showed the
new one away Lat
