Strong Breezes from
the Eastward steering
at 7 1/2 a m Spoke 11
Dark Marcus of Sag Harbour
35 months ago I did

Saturday the 15th
fresh Breezes from the
S & E steering by to the
E S E at 5 1/2 m hauled
aback for him to come
down at 6 Spoke him
and he came on Board

Sunday the 16th
from this time to the 27th
working in to Eastward
slowly shortening sail nights
during the time saw
nothing of note

Thursday the 27th the E S E
the wind from the E S E
steering by to the N E foggy
and some squalls
of rain

Friday the 28th
moderate Breezes from the E S E
steering by to the N E at 7
1/2 m set sea watches
with the intention of making
a Strait course for the
Sandwich Islands

Saturday the 29th
moderate Breezes from the S W
steering E by N employed in fitting
tugging and putting up new mast & stays at the
main

towards the Sandwich Islands

Sunday the 30th of June 1850
moderate Breezes from the S W
steering E by N saw jumpers
and porpoises latter part steering E
at 31.54 long 24
174:24

Monday the 1st of July
moderate Breezes from the
S W steering E by N employed
in fitting the Bolt Spout Cap

Tuesday the 2^d
first part light Breezes from
the Westward steering E by N
latter part calm employed
leathering the jaws of the main
topsal yard

Wednesday the 3^d
light Breezes from the S W
steering E by N

Thursday the 4th light winds from
the S W steering E by N saw
Porpoises

Friday the 5th
light Breezes and fine weather steering
E by N

Saturday the 6th
very slight winds from the Southward
steering E by N 168:41

Sunday the 7th
light Breezes and fine weather
steering E by N 32:28 167:47
