

Apr Monday 2nd 1906 This day in port good weather on bend the maine. gallant sail to rescue one man forehead etc complain out to sea with his eyes and after he said that he was blind after arrived in this port the Captain took him shore to a doctor to see if he was. and the Doctor said he was not blind his eyes sight was good he dont to work so the Captain told him to go to work or go shore he would not work he went on shore. the starboard watch go on shore and so end

Apr Tuesday 3rd 1906 This day began with rain all day in port doin nothing at evening it hold up the port watch go shore

Apr Wednesday 4th 1906 This day began fine weather in port working on the gallant sail finish it and bend it. on bend the maine upertopsail at 2 p.m. began to rain

Apr Thursday 5 1906 This day in port began fine weather working on the maine sail in the evening the port watch go on shore and

Apr Friday 6 This day in began with light rain in port working at the maine sail part of the day the Three master arrive at 2 p.m. The Starboard watch go a shore end.

Apr Saturday 7 - 1906 This day in port working on the maine sail and ~~receiving~~ receiving provision and ~~that~~ cask from the schooner the mate is sick and the Captain send for the Doctor and he said he must go a shore in the hospital so he went. the port watch go on shore and so end

Apr Sunday 8th 1906 This day in port fine weather nothing doin the mate is still sick a shore the Starboard ~~go~~ watch go on shore and so end

Apr Monday 9th 1906 This day in port light rain part of the day finish the maine sail the mate is still sick a shore port watch go shore

Apr Tuesday 10th 1906 This day in port rain part of the day bend on the maine sail getting ready to go a long side the Schooner the mate is still sick the Starboard watch go on shore

Apr Wednesday 11th 1906 This day in port rain during the day nothing doin finish paint the boat in the evening port watch go on shore so end

Apr Thursday 12th 1906 This day in port fine weather hall along side the Schooner and start to brake out oil the watch go on shore

Apr Friday 13th 1906 This day began fine weather long side the Schooner the mate came on board this morning and also began put oil on board. the port watch go on shore

Apr Saturday 14th 1906 This day in port alongside the Schooner give her oil and taking Schoot. at evening the Starboard watch go shore

Apr Sunday 15th 1906 This day in port along side the Schooner doin nothing today the port watch go on shore and in the afternoon the bark Charles W Morgan arrived

Apr Monday 16th 1906 This day in port broke out oil and given the Schooner light rain during the day the watch go a shore so end
