William H Taylor a Notary Public duly commissioned
and sworn pending in the City of New Bedford County
and Commonwealth of Massachusetts personally appeared
Henry Daggett master of the Ship *William West*
of Fairhaven of the burthen of 290 tons or thereabouts
now lying in the harbor of New Bedford aforesaid
and states that he sailed in said Ship from
the Port of Fairhaven on the 15th day of January
last, having on board a cargo consisting of
Sperm and Whale Oil, bound for Fairhaven

day of May instant, and having encountered
heavy and tempestuous weather on the passage
and fearing loss and damage in consequence
thereof desires to note his protest against the
winds and waves, storm tempests, gales of
wind, heavy seas and all other causes whereby
the said Ship may have sustained loss or
damage in her hull, tackle, apparel, cargo
or freight, with liberty to caluminate the same
at pleasure.
