Personally appeared Francis M. Gardner Master of the Ship Sloop of Fairhaven, and on oath declared that Thomas Hervey, Henry L. Eastman, Thomas R. Anthony, William H. North, John S. Chase, Samuel Fox, Jose Leal, Francisco Silver, Albert Horn and Jose Luis deserted their ship at San Francisco; that Edward M. Thalding deserted at Pagan; that John Campbell and Francis C. Smith deserted at Fairhaven before sailing on the voyage; that Frank Fox, Silvanus Allen, Joseph Francis, Joseph Coates, William H. Durham, and Lewis Francis were discharged at San Francisco, and that Stephen B. Fisher, Albert Johnson, and Michael Wozar were discharged at their own request at Fairhaven and there being no Consular agent of the United States at that port no certificate of such discharge could be obtained.
