in the Island of Brazil. That Thomas Brown
and William Parker deserted at San Carlos. That
James Clark a native of the Sandwich Islands
was elected and taken out of the ship as such
at Bahia Africa. That Richard H. Ford
Peter Swank, Lucas Rogers, Antone Francis, John
Bill, Charles Mear, Charles Peter, John Davis
William Mear, Richard and John were regularly
discharged at Bahia Africa in the presence
and by consent of the Consul, but the certificate of
such discharge has been lost or unintentionally
mistaken and cannot now be found. That Charles
Pandora did not sail from this port in the ship
and that William Johnson exchanged with a
man belonging to the Ship Maria Theresa and
failed in that ship with the consent of all concerned

coast of Peru at his own request and there being
no Consul agent of the United States at that Port
no certificate of such discharge could be obtained.
and that Peter Attoni was discharged at his
own request and by consent of the Consul of the
United States at Valparaiso and that the certificate
of such discharge, if obtained, has been lost or
unintentionally mistaken
