I Lawrence Grinnell Treasurer of the New Bedford
and Taunton Rail Road Corporation do hereby
certify on oath that the Engine and wood house
belonging to the said Corporation and situated
at the terminus of the said Rail Road in this
city, and insured by the Hartford Fire Insur-
ance Company per Policy No 23 dated September
27th 1847 for the sum of Fifty hundred dollars
was on the 11th day of September instant seriously
damaged by fire; that the lowest estimate we
have been able to obtain for repairing the same is
Twenty one hundred dollars that we had
no other insurance on the said buildings than
that above described; that its value at the time the
fire occurred was at least Four thousand five
hundred dollars; that it is wholly the property
of the said Corporation and that I have no know-
ledge in what manner the fire originated.
