

July 1844 Ship Barclay of New Bedford No Army Agr.
 Built in New Bedford in 1793 - 2 Decks 281 Tons 14 ft 8 in. Coppers
 2 chains 14 ft 10 in. Anch good Rigging & Sail fair Rat A2

Bottom caulked & sheathed in 1838 - Put new knee sheath & top 1840
 Top side Stanchion Rails Planking water ways. Stem Stern post
 all new in 1843 - All the spars & rigging after part ship bottom
 new - also above water. Sheath & copper all put in good order in
 1843 - in 1850 had her Bottom caulked & sheathed
 and Coppered ship in good order in 1852
 Copper on Bottom made the ship put in good order
 In May 54 had her top caulked and put in good
 order. Bottom copper the ship appears to be in good
 order for a voyage.

1844 Oct- Ship Brighton of New Bedford C.R. Tucker Agr.
 Built in New York in 1824 2 Decks. 352 Tons. 16 ft 8 in. Coppers
 2 chains 14 ft 10 in. Anch good Rigging & Sail fair Rat A2

Put new timbers put in lower hold, new ceiling in do new out board
 above waist new side new bulwarks all around new main mast
 17 new Stanchions new rails - caulked Chum and Shille in 1844
 Top caulked bottom copper in 1844 - Sailed 7th with loss from ast-
 rip & sail again same year - By bottom copper ship in
 good order. In 1854 had one half new wales lower
 deck frame refastened ceiling in lower hold refastened
 new upper deck and part new frame ship top put in
 good order. Bottom caulked sheath & coppered ship in
 good order. In Oct 1854 had top caulked & put in fair
 order. Bottom coppered. Ship in fair order in N Bedford
 In the Spring of 1855 bottom caulked sheathed
 and coppered in Dartmouth

July 1844 Ship Joshua of New Bedford No Army Agr.
 Built at Fairhaven in 1823 2 Decks 352 Tons 16 ft 8 in. Coppers
 2 chains 14 ft 10 in. Anch good Rigging & Sail fair Rat A2

Give oak frame - Top caulk lower deck up new main mast
 Sheath & copper ship put in good order in 1844 -
 In April 1847 Top Canvased Bottom Coppered &
 Ship put in good order for a voyage. In June 51
 had some new wales & new streak above the waist top
 caulked and put in good order. Bottom coppered
 In Aug 1854 had 10 new knees put in lower deck frame,
 lower deck frame refastened, new upper deck, ceiling in
 hold refastened. Bolt caulked sheath and copper. Ship appears to
 be in fair order. In Aug. 1858, top caulked, bottom
 coppered - Ship put in first rate order.
 In Aug. 1862, caulked all over - bottom sheathed and
 coppered - Ship put in good order - In June 1866 had
 her top caulked and put in good order. Gunboard
 & woodwork some caulked Bottom coppered ship
 in good order. - In May 1871 had some repairs
 about the stern ship caulked all over Bottom
 sheathed & coppered ship put in first rate order
 new wales & new knees in lower deck frame & some
 new knees between decks -

1844 Oct- Ship Joshua of Fairhaven No Army Agr.
 Built at Kingston in 1826 1 Deck 148 Tons 14 ft 8 in. Coppers
 2 chains 14 ft 10 in. Anch fair Sail Rigging fair Rat A2

1859. Repairing and put all the spars & rigging. Rig & Sail Aug in 1859
 Caulk all over Aug bottom sheath in 1844 had several pieces of plank tak-
 en out about the ship timbers for a strong top caulk and bottom copper in
 (rather slender build) In 1848 rebuilt top & bottom and made nearly
 as good as when new. Caulked all over sheathed & coppered
 In June 1851 had her Bottom coppered ship put
 in fair order - In June 53 caulked all
 over bottom sheath and coppered Bark in fair order
 In June 54 caulked all over, bottom sheathed and copper.
 Bark put in good order.
