In Apr 1872 Ceiling in lower hold all refastened
new waterways aft on each side length of House
one new Counter timber on port side two new
standing knees aft between decks new Windlass
bows fitted for Ice 2 new Top masts and top
gallant mast new fore rigging, and head
stays all new. Top cantoken Bottom Cope and
2 chains $1\frac{1}{2}$ in one being new

Ship put in first rate order.
In Aug. 1858, caulked all over-bottom
sheathed & coppered - Ship put in first rate order.
In July 1862, sheathed with Oak around the bow
in the wake of ice - bottom coppered - Ship put
in first rate order.
In June 1866 had her top caulked and put in
good order bottom coppered, ship in first rate
order.
In June 1872 - top caulked - decks caulked - bottom
with sheathed and coppered - Ship put in good order -
