plank sheath. 5 new streaks above bands & rails from the star-
board gangway to the stem. new Bullwork forward out
side and in ship caulked all over Bottom sheathed
and coppered the ship appears to be sound and in good
order. In June 1854 top caulked, Bottom coppered
Back in fair order. had one new chain & in Aug. 1856,
caulked all over, bottom sheathed and coppered. Ship
appears to be in good order.
