Built at Fair Haven in 1839. 2 decks 233 tons. 1st rate
2 Channel 1840. Anch. Side Rigging Fair Rate A 2 1/2

In 1839 Caulked & Sheathed. In 1844 Bottom Coppered
Ship put in good order. In 1852 Caulked all over Bottom
Sheathed & Coppered Ship put in good order. In 1857. Caulked all
over Bottom Sheathed and coppered. Ship in good order.
In Aug. 1858. had top caulked put in good order
bottom & had in a narrow frame. Bottom
Coppered. In Aug. 1860 Caulked all over Bottom
Sheathed and Coppered Ship put in good
order. In Sept. 1865. had some repairs
in top - lower deck frame repaired - one
new breast hook - walls and top sides
repaired with trenails - caulked all over
Bottom Sheathed & Coppered. In May 1871. had deck
and top sides caulked to light water mark had
some plank taken out of bottom above water
lumber found sound ship top put in first
rate order. Bottom sheathed to light water
mark bottom coppered all over Ship appears
to be good order.

1847 Ship Solconda New Bedford George Howland capt
built in Hanover in 1809. 2 decks 340 tons 16 1/2 ft depth
fastened 3cc. 11.25 Anch fair Rigging good Rate A 2 1/2

Rebuilt top & bottom in 1839. Top caulked
bottom coppered. Ship put in first rate order in
June 1847. In 1857 Bottom Coppered Ship put in good
order. In the Spring of 1858 caulked all over Bottom
Sheathed & coppered. In Aug. 1859. had her top
caulked and put in good order - garboard and
woodend seams caulked - bottom coppered -
rigged into a Bark - Bark in fair order.

No Ship George Fair Haven Agt. D. Bedford
1847 Built in Hanover in 1819. 2 decks 273 tons. 1st rate
3cc. 1 in 1840. Anch. Side Rigging good coppered

In 1847 Rebuilt in Malapoiset top & Bottom new
decks frame. Caulked all over Bottom Sheathed
& Coppered Ship in good order. In 1853 had top caulked
bottom coppered. In 1857. In Sept. 1857. ship caulked
all over, bottom sheathed & coppered. And put in good order.
In May 1862. had her top caulked - new sheathing
on the keel new gips - garboard and wood end seams
examined - bottom coppered - Ship put in good order - in
June - Spars and rigging - In May 1864 returned
in account of the illness of the Captain -
sailed again about as she came in - in
good order. In Sept. 1865. caulked
all over, bottom sheathed & coppered - Ship
put in fair order.
In July 1869. had her top caulked, put
in good order. Bottom coppered Bark in
fair order.

Built in Fair Haven in 1848. 1 deck 180 tons 16 ft depth
Coppered 2cc 7/8 in Sails & Rigging Good Rate A 1 1/2

Ship vessel red sheathed. - In Oct 1851 caulked
sheathed & coppered vessel in good order
In 1854 had her bottom coppered - In
Oct. 1860 caulked all over, Bottom sheathed
and coppered In Nov 1867 had some repairs
put in fair order bottom coppered
