Built in Stonington Aug 1831 2 dks 445 ton 15 ft of opp put
S.C.C. 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 on good Sails & Rig fair Rate 2 1/2

In 1851 caulked all over Bottom sheathed & coppered
with yellow metal had new Boag out side &
in the ship appears to be rather a good vessel of her
age acting in lower hold has never been removed
but they say her timbers are sound apart Rigging
in good order

July 1851 Bark Capt Vaud of Westport Henry Wilcox agt
Built in New Bedford in 1851 1 deck 250 tons 12 ft of
S.C.C. 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 on good Sails & Rigging fair Rate A 1

In 1851 Buier, calked, sheathed & coppered.
In the Winter of 1852 had her top caulked
Copper on Bottom repaired & made good.
In April 1857 top caulked - bottom coppered -
Bark in good order - In April 1862 caulked all
over Bottom sheathed & coppered two new masts
Bark put in good order In Apr. 1865
top caulked and put in good order copper
on bottom patched - Bark put in order
for a short voyage

Sept 1837 Ship Alice Thayer of New Bedford L. Kolloch agt
Built in New Bedford in 1835 13 dks 400 ton 17 ft of
S.C.C. 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 on fair 3 Sails & Rig good Rate A 1/2

In Aug 1857 had two new masts ship caulked
all over Bottom sheathed & coppered ship put
in good order. In Sept 1858 top caulked Bottom
coppered ship put in fair order

In Sept 1859 had two bulwarks around the
bow - Built put in good order, caulked all
over, bottom sheathed and coppered - two new
masts and nearly all new rigging.

Oct 1851 Ship Atlantic of New Bedford Capt R. W. May
Built in New Bedford in 1851 2 dks 360 tons coppered
S.C.C. 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 on good Sails & Rig good Rate A 1

Built caulked sheathed & coppered in New Bedford
in N.B. in 1851 In Aug 1854 had her top caulked
and bottom coppered ship put in good order
In the Winter of 1859 - 60 - caulked all over -
bottom sheathed and coppered

In July 1865 caulked all over - bottom sheathed
and coppered - Bark put in fair order
In April 1868 had her top caulked &
put in good order bottom coppered
In May 1872 had part new upper deck & standing benches Bottom
decks top caulked and bottom coppered
