

82 June Schooner Amelia of Andover N.H. agent  
1857 Built in Bristol in 1843 1st bottom copper  
Dec. 11 1/2 and Jan 1st Rig fair Rate \$2

Copper fastened and zinc on the skin Built by A.iram  
Seward in 1843. On 1st 2nd and 3rd chains are one  
90 fathoms and the other 70 fathoms long she appears to be  
in good order she is a long narrow flat schooner  
On 1st 2nd and 3rd new timbered in lower hold, caulked and coppered  
Rig put in fair order. On spring 1st 2nd coppered on  
bottom plates and put in fair order for a  
short voyage. Anchors 1st 2nd 3rd One 500 lb one 400 lb

July 1851. Bark Alice of Cold Spring, J. H. Jones, agent  
2 decks, 281 tons, 12 ft draft, coppered  
A. 2 c.c. Large, Anchors good. Rigging and sails fair  
In 1848. Had bottom caulked, felted, sheathed and coppered.

83 Built in New Bedford N.H. agent  
Built in Baltimore in 1813. 3 decks 315 tons coppered  
Dec. 11 1/2 and Jan 1st Rig fair Rate \$2 1/2

It is said that this ship was built in Baltimore  
in 1813 and was brought into the United  
States service in 1815 or 1820. Ship was rebuilt  
in Boston by J. & S. D. and made  
nearly as good as new. In 1842 in Boston  
was raised upon cranes and had an entire  
new upper deck and all above added  
to the ship and at that time ship put in  
good order. In December 5th ship caulked  
all over bottom sheathed & coppered. Ship  
rigged into a whaler in the ship sound  
strong and good. From all appearances  
In April 1st had the wooden sheathing taken off  
the bottom. Bottom caulked & painted with pitch  
copied on the stem, top caulked & the Bark  
put in good order.

May 1861. Bark A. P. Tucker of Dartmouth N.H. agent  
New Bedford - J. & W. R. Wing  
Built in Dartmouth in 1851 1st 2nd 3rd coppered  
Dec. 11 1/2 and Jan 1st Rig fair Rate \$1 1/2

Built caulked sheathed & coppered in 1857. The bark is  
a good narrow clipper built. In Aug. 5th caulked all  
over bottom sheathed and coppered. In 1861 top  
caulked & bottom coppered. Bark in good order  
In May 1864, top caulked and put in  
good order - bottom coppered - Bark in fair order  
In Jan. 1865, top caulked, bottom coppered.  
Bark in fair order -  
In Oct. 1865, caulked all over bottom sheathed  
and coppered put in good order.  
In the spring of 1871 had new upper deck  
had some new timbers in the run ship  
put in good order bottom coppered
