 Sep 1844 Ship Weaver of Fairhaven A. Severy Agt
 Built in Stonington 1811 2 Decks 207 Tons 12 ft. 6 in. Copper
 & Chain 18. 1/2. Anch Fair Rigging Fair Rats A 2 1/2

Rep. in top and bottom 1828 - bottom calk and sheath in 1841 -
 new rails plus new water ways upper and lower deck repair bottom
 coppered in 1844 - On Aug 1845 had nearly all new
 lower deck frame new clamps in lower hold
 ceiling all out for ward the fore mast had several
 new timbers new stem new apron new back stays
 several streaks of ceiling taken out above the
 fore mast timbers found good ceiling in lower
 hold all refastened. Bottom calked then
 & coppered in fair order. In the Spring of 1846
 was repaired in bottom had an entire new
 top & bottom calked. Bottom sheathed & coppered
 put in good order. In Nov. 1858 had her top
 calked - bends calked and sheathed - bottom coppered
 ship in fair order. In March 1859 returned
 leaky - hove out bottom examined found the leak in the
 scuff of the keel - leak stopped - keel refastened - had
 sister keelsons put in in the wake of mainmast - 20 feet
 long and well secured - new step to mainmast - but ship
 is now tight and appears to be in fair order. see below

Dec 1844 Ship Carver of Westport Davis & Cory Agt
 Built at Portsmouth 1825 2 Decks 262 Tons 13 ft. Copper
 & Chain large size 1/2. Anch good Rigging fair Rats A 2 1/2

Calk'd Sheath and Copper in N York top calk in Westport put new
 plank sheath bows opened and found sound in 1841 - Top calk'd
 and bottom coppered in 1844 - Sheathed & coppered
 in 1848 - Geo. Gifford built Bottom coppered & ship
 put in good order in 1852 two masts top calked

Westport
 In May 1859 - sailed and returned leaky
 bottom stripped calked sheathed and
 coppered - found the leak to be caused by
 several iron bolts in bottom that had rusted out
 and when fitted was perfectly tight in harbor

 Built at New Bedford 1811 2 Decks 187 Tons 14 ft. 6 in. Copper
 & Chain 18. 1/2. Anch good Rigging fair Rats A 2 1/2

Calk'd Sheath and Copper in 1845 - In Oct 1857 top calk'd
 & Bottom coppered Ship in good order
 In May 1858 had her top calked bottom coppered
 Ship put in good order. In the Spring of
 1858 - calked all over bottom sheathed & coppered
 Ship put in good order.

Dec 1845 Ship Hercules of New Bedford Geo. G. Gifford Agt
 Built at New Bedford 1810 2 Decks 290 Tons 14 ft. 6 in. Copper
 & Chain 18. 1/2. Anch Fair Rigging fair Rats A 3

Rebuilt top and bottom in 1837 ceiling taken out from keel to upper
 deck all new timbers taken out and new ceiling hung. Many struts
 many rails calk'd all over and sheath. 1848 Top calk'd and
 bottom coppered - 1852 Top calk'd Ship put in good order.
