In June 1867 taken on the ways and Garbner and Woodard seams caulked and other parts of Bottom tried. Caulking found good, about 600 new sheets copper put on Bottom several pieces of plank taken out of top to expose ~~to~~ found sound. Ship appears to be in order for a short voyage.

In April 1869, 150 new timbers in lower hold. Ciled over in lower hold. Ten hanging knees under lower deck. New breasthooks & painter fore & aft. New lower deck frame fore & aft. Nearly a new Top throughout. Thoroughly refastened with tunnels through & through two standing knees between decks. New main-mast, Spars & Rigging in good order. Back in good order.
