Walls and two streaks below, new, straight
upper wale amidships New Clamps and
streaks in Lower Hold, new Timber
from Mizzen aft. entire and a large
number of timbers on the sides (Nearly
all new abreast the lower deck) New Ceiling

dead wood and Aft part of Keelson
with three or four new Transoms New Stairs
and Counter and four or five new
Floors, below the wale and three Aft
Floors. New work outboard, trunnels
through & through with Locust
and wedged inside & outside.
