Robertson, capt. Built in New Haven 1821 - 2 decks,
362 tons, Cop. Fastened, & C.C. 1/4 1/4 Anch. good
Rigging fair. Rate \$1 1/2*

In 1836 had new out board above the benches
In 1847 had new benches some life timbers some
new stanchions, two new decks and joists, stan-
ding knee between decks. Ship car. shed bottom
sheathed & sheathed & coppered. Ship put in
first rate order. In June 1851 Bottom Coppered Ship
in good order. In June 1855 Caulked all over bottom
Churn and sheathed & coppered. had 3 new masts. Ship
put in good order. In Oct. 1859, had two new water-
ways and new plank above the water - new half
top timber - new stanchions all around - new
water ways and plank sheathing new rails, new stem
new bulwarks outside and in - Bark put in good
order - top caulked - bottom coppered.
In Apr. 1865, had some repairs and several new timbers
and transoms in the stern - several new plank put
in bottom in stern. Caulked all over bottom sheathed
& coppered - 134. put in good order. In Aug 1870 part new
upper planks. Bark put in good order Bottom Coppered
upper planks.

*Sept. Ship Rodman of N. Bedford. Morgan
1847 Built in N. Bedford in 1827. 200 tons 371 ton C.P. 1/4
2 C.C. 1/4 1/4 Anch. good Tails 8 Rigging good Rate \$2 1/2*

In 1847 had a new life caulked & coppered ship put
in first rate order. In 1851 Bottom Coppered and ship put in good
order. In Aug 1858 had 8 new wales on each side
lower deck frame refastened. Caulked all over
Bottom sheathed & coppered. In Sept. 1859, had
two new decks and frames - new waterways
in upper and lower decks - Bark put in good
order - bottom caulked, sheathed and coppered -

*Ship Robert of New Bedford. E. Mafford capt.
Built in Boston in 1830 - 2 decks 306 tons Cop.
Fastened 2 C.C. 1/4 1/4 1/4 Anch. good Rigging good
Rate \$2 1/2*

In Boston 1847 had all new
stanchions, new plank above the water
new bow inside & out new keel nearly all
new spars and standing rigging. her bottom
caulked & sheathed. In the Spring 1857, her
bottom caulked sheathed & coppered. Ship ap-
pears to be in good order for some time.

*June Bark R. G. Barston of Mattapoisett. R. G. Barston capt.
1861 Built in Mattapoisett in 1851 1st 211 ton 191 ton
Copper 2 C.C. 1/4 1/4 1/4 Anch. good Sails & Rig. new Rate \$1 1/2*

The R. G. Barston is a one deck Bark 60 ft long 23 ft
wide and 10 ft high she appears to be a well built Bark
more of a schooner model than of a ship caulked
sheathed and coppered in Mattapoisett in 58
In Dec. 1853 had her top caulked. Bottom coppered.
Bark put in fair order.
In July 1856 had her top caulked and bottom coppered
Bark in good order. In April 1859, caulked
all over bottom sheathed & coppered - Bark
in good order.
