

July Ship Robin Hood of Mystic. C. Mallory agt
1851 Built in Boston 1824 oak 895 ton 15 ft dpt. Copper
2 c.c. 1/4 + 1/4 On good Sails & Rigging fair Rate 2 1/2

Built of oak. Caulked all over & sheathed all
new planks above the waist stanchions, plank keel
and waterway & rails, had some standing knee
ceiling lower deck frame and water rafter stowed
some ceiling out of lower hold ceiling timbers found
good all this in 1848. to the Capt. & crew

July Ship Romulus of Mystic Chas. Mallory agt
1851 Built in Maine in 1831 2 oaks 365 ton 14 ft dpt
2 c.c. 1/4 + 1/4 On large Sails & Rigging fair Rate 2 1/2

In 1851 had two streaks of ceiling out of lower hold
timbers found good Bottom caulked & sheathed
and coppered Sails & Rig in fair order the ship appears
to be sound and strong for one of her age

Sept Bark Richmond of New Bedford. C. Mallory agt
1851 Built in Long Island in 1835 3 oaks 110 ton 14 ft dpt
2 c.c. 1/4 + 1/4 On good Sails & Rigging fair Rate 2 1/2

In 1849 rebuilt all over and made nearly
as good as new. In July 1851 rigged in new
Bark vessel caulked all over Bottom she
and coppered. Vessel put in first rate order
the Richmond was always considered a
first rate sea boat and a good sea going
vessel. In April 1851 bottom coppered & Bark
put in first rate order. In Aug '57 had two bottom
coppered, bark put in good order. In Aug. 1860
caulked all over, and coppered on the stern to ballast
mark, had several mud spars - Bark appears to
be in good order.

Sept Bark Robert Morrison of New Bedford R. H. Mowbray agt
1851 Built in Maine in 1847 2 oaks 307 ton 14 ft dpt
2 c.c. 1/4 + 1/4 On fair Sails & Rigging fair Rate 2 1/2

In Sept 1851 Caulked all over Bottom sheathed
sheathed & coppered. This ship appears to be a well
built strong rough vessel. In May 1854 had her
top caulked and copper on bottom patched.
In June '57 had her top caulked and put in good order
bottom coppered. In 1861 Caulked all over Bottom
sheathed & coppered Bark put in good order.
In June 1865 had some repairs about
the top - Bark put in fair order - bottom
coppered. In June 1868 Repaired and put in
fair order. Caulked all over Bottom sheathed
and coppered Bark appears to be in fair order.
