 Copper on the bottom painted and put in good order for a short
 voyage. In April 1877 had top calked and put
 in good order bottom coppered

About the year 1858 had new plank on
 bottom Schooner put in first rate order
 In Sept 1865 Calked all over bottom sheathed
 & Coppered and put in good order
 Had several hanging knees under deck

 in fair order. Copper on the bottom repaired and put
 in order for a voyage. In Jan 1872 Calked sheathed
 & Coppered and put in good order
