 and ship put in good order - In Oct 1850 had Bottom
 caulked Sheath and coppered ship in good order. In
 May 54 had her top caulked and bottom coppered.
 Ship put in good order. In May 57 had ceiling
 out of lower holes from upper deck clamps to nearly
 floor timber heads, all bad timbers removed and
 replaced with new, ceiling, new, found new breast
 hooks in lower holes, new lower deck and frame, ship
 caulked all over, bottom sheathed and coppered, ship
 put in good order, likewise had new fore and after
 horns at the same time. In July 1860 had her top
 caulked and bottom coppered. Ship put in
 fair order. In April 1864, Ship put in good

 In the winter of 49-50 had Top caulked Copper on bottom painted
 and put in good order for a short voyage, repaired in Mattapoisett.
 In the spring of 1852 rebuilt Top & Bottom and made
 a very good vessel caulked Sheath and coppered
 In winter of 1854 had her Top caulked Brig in good
 order
 In Sept. 1858 bottom coppered - Ship put in
 fair order. In April 1860 had some repairs
 about the top - Ship put in good order - caulked
 Sheath and coppered - In June 1862
 Top painted - Spars rigging put in good order
 In Dec. 1863, top put in good order - bottom coppered
 In June 1865, top caulked and about one
 fourth new copper on bottom - Ship appears
 to be in fair order for a short voyage
 had new bulwarks outside in fore and
 of foremast - new knight heads.
