1851 Built in Medford in 1846. 3 dth 354 dm 17 ft 4 in
see 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 in good Sails & Rig good Rate A

In 1851 Caulked all over Bottom sheathed & coppered
In good order ship in good order

In May 1860, had 30 Shuts of Copper put
on bottom above water - and fitted for a Dry Month
cruise

June Bar Pump of Mattapois R I Barstow Agt
1851 Built in Maymouth in 1840 1 dth 183 dm 9 ft 4 in
Copp'd & sec in Sails & Rig good - Rate A 2 1/2

In May 1851 had some partial repairs about top
Ship caulked all over Bottom sheathed & coppered. Had
new main rigging. The Bark appears to be in very good
order her chains & other short for a while. The deck is
new for the Coastwise trade. In Sept 1853 top caulked
and put in fair order. Copper on Bottom patched.
Vessel appears to be in order for a short voyage.
In Nov 1853 caulked sheath & coppered
and put in good order. In May 1854, had
several new stanchions - some new plank
and other repairs about the top, top caulked &
put in good order, copper on bottom patched - Bark
appears to be in fair order. - In Oct 1860 had
ceiling out in new timber found good. top
caulked and put in good order. Garboard
wooden beams caulked. Bottom coppered
The Bark appears to be in fair order

June Ship Jobbia Wharton of New Bedford, J. H. Wharton
1851 Built in Bath Me. In 1851. 2 dth 303 dm 10 ft 1 in
2 dth Copper fast anchors good Sails & Rig good - Rate A 1

The Jobbia Wharton was built caulked & rig
in Bath. Sheathed & coppered in 1851. In
the ship is of a clipper model. In spring 1855
had her top calked and bottom coppered & ship
put in good order. In Nov. 1859 caulked all
over bottom sheathed and coppered ship put in
good order. - In Oct. 1864 top caulked
bottom coppered - Ship put in good order

July Ship J. H. Waterman of Stonington Ct. J. H. Waterman
1851 Built in Mansfield 1850 2 dth 303 dm 16 ft 6 in
see 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 in good Sails & Rig good - Rate A 1 1/2

The J. H. Waterman is a long sharp ship. In June
1851 ship caulked all over bottom sheathed &
coppered. She has the appearance of being a fine
built ship
