Remarks

In the Spring of 1859, top caulked and bottom coppered. Plank put in fair order. - In Aug 1862, had a new upper deck and all new framed, milled ceiling out in hold from floor timber heads 6 feet in width nearly five & half timbers, four round - the old ceiling refastened - sheathing stripped off bottom to ballast mark - garboard and wool and reamers caulked - bottom above

the sheathing caulked - bottom copped to
11 feet - water top and deck caulked - new
windlass - rigging and spars put in good order
