Built in New Bedford in 1855. 3 dh. Tons
Copp. 4t ecc Anchors good Rate A 1

Sheathed & Coppered in Nov 1855.
In June 1862, caulked all over - decks caulked
bottom coppered on the stem - nearly all new
rigging - Bark put in first rate order -
In Aug 1867,
caulked all over bottom sheathed & coppered
Bark in first rate order.

Bark Huntress of New Bedford, Cook & Snow, Agt
Built in Mattapoisett in 1856 - 583 shd. Copper fastened
2 C. C. 1 1/2 & 1 1/4 - 2 anchors - one 2200 lb. one 1900 lb. - 2 Decks
Rate A 1

In August 1856, ship caulked, sheathed and coppered.
In July 57 returned, in consequence of mauling among
the crew: - In Aug. 57 had her top caulked. Ship
put in good order. In June 1862 caulked
all over - decks caulked - bottom coppered on the
stem - Bark put in first rate order.

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Ship Hiawatha of New Bedford J. R. H. Nye, Agt
Built in New Bedford in 1855 - 555 tons Copper fastened
2 C. C. 1 1/2 & 1 1/4 inches, 90 fathom - 3 anchors 2,000, 1675, & 562 lbs.
1 Deck Rate A 1

Built, caulked, sheathed and coppered in the summer
of 1856 - In June 1862, caulked all over
decks caulked - bottom coppered on the stem -
Ship put in first rate order.

Brig Hopeton of Sippican - Obed Delano Agent
Built in Conn. in 1861 - 125 tons Copper fastened - Chain
Hair - Anchors Hair - 1 deck - Rate A 1 1/2

In 1867 - caulked, sheathed & coppered, & put in good order.
