

Schooner Horace Staples of New Bedford
Built in Milport Mass in 1857. 171 tons
Copper fast 200 in each of 60 fath. Anchors 130 lbs
+ 800 lbs 1 Deck Rate A1

Built of Oak Chestnut & Locust. Lignum vitae
through & through with Locust. Copper fast
to light water mark. Five foot poop foreward
main main mast. In September 1860 recanted
rigging taken off and refitted and put in good
good order. In Oct 1862 taken on the way to bottom
Caulked & painted

Schooner Helen of New Bedford - John Gordon -
Built in New Bedford in 1864 - 190 tons
Iron fastened - 2 Chain Cable 1 1/2 & 1 1/4
2 Anchors - 1200 & 1300 lbs 1 deck Rate A1
Built caulked & painted in the Spring of 1864
First rate Center board Schooner

Schooner Jason of New Bedford Harney Bartlett
Built in Ireland State of Maine in 1863
135 1/2 tons Iron fastened Chain Large Anchors good
1 Deck Rate A1 1/2

In 1866 cast away. Got off and rebuilt. Had
new keel & keelson & several new timbers and plank
in bottom. Bottom refastened. Schooner put in
fair order. Caulked all over. In the Spring of 1861
had top caulked. In Oct 1861 had bottom caulked
Vessel put in fair order

Scho. Wm Crawford - Chas. Thatcher 160 Regts
Built in Phippsburg - Maine in 1848 - 131 tons
Copper fastened - 2 - C.C. 1 1/2 & 1 1/4 - Anchors good
1 Deck - Rate A2 -

In the Winter of 1863 had ceiling out
of after hold - 140 new timbers put in all
inlaid - ceiling out of fore hold - timbers
found sound - some ceiling out in both
sides amidships, timbers former good - had
new sternchairs - some new rails - 1 transom
bottom partially refastened - caulked all over
bottom painted - new chain plates - new
lower dead eyes - shows nearly all new -
rigging good - Schooner appears to be in
very fair order
