of a new deck frame - top repaired and
put in good order - caulked to ballast mark
copper below has been on one or two years
The Schooner appears to be in good order
and a very good vessel - (center board)

Loring & Sons Agent - Built in Philadelphia in 1849
846 tons copper & iron fast 2 cc 1 1/2 in & 1 1/4 in Anchor good
Hulk & Deck Rate A 2

In April 1866 had her top
repaired and put in good order. New lower deck
between the fore & main hatch. Caulked all over
Bottom sheathing & coppered. Saw new masts
several new spars new Brindley. The Bark appears
to be now in fair order for eight years
In June 1868. Top caulked wherever
needed. Bark put in good order.
