Remarks

In June 1866 caulked all iron bottom sheathed
& coppered & put in good order

In May had her garboard & wood end seams calked, Copper on
bottom put in good order, new rails all round, new knight
heads, new breast hook over the bowsprit, vessel top
calked wherever needed, and put in fair order

In Winter 1871-2nd caulked and coppered ^{repaired} and put in
good order, and rigged into a brig.
