1907 P.M. Strong breeze and cloudy and high topping sea running. Ship run under easy sail wind from E. Watch on deck employed repairing Chafing gear and we brake out two barrel of meat and one pork end of the day Gat: 35-00 Longitude 60-48

Remarks Friday September the 20th 1907
P.M. Calm all day with high topping sea running employed set up main top and gallant back stays and sawing Smoke sail end of day
Gat: 35-05 Longitude 58-59

Remarks Saturday September the 21 1907
P.M. light breeze wind from SE employed brake out flour bread and trees reving forebraces fore and main gallant hallard. end of day. Gat: 34-53 Longitude 59-49

Remarks Sunday 22 1907
P.M. fine clear weather wind from south with hot sail set for Alameda complain with women disease shafts end of day
Gat: 35-00 Longitude 58-55

Remarks Monday the 23 1907
P.M. light breeze and clear weather wind from SE employed repairing Chafing gear and sawing smoke sail
end of the day Gat: 35-03 Longitude 58-14

Remarks Tuesday September the 24th 1907

P.M. calm and clear weather employed sawing smoke sail wash of the deck. end of day. Gat: 35-12 Longitude 58-22

Remarks Wednesday September the 25th 1907
P.M. fine clear weather wind from SW. Courses SE-E with all sail set employed sawing smoke sail end of day
Gat 34-48 Longitude 58-26

Remarks Thursday September the 26 1907
P.M. strong breeze and cloudy. Wind from SW. Courses SE-E. and all ~~that~~ both afft the sail out at 12 clock someone saw a large whale and he see the ship gone to windward we were lower the boats employed topping smoke sail. end of day. no. Gat: Longitude 58-14

Remarks Friday September the 27 1907
P.M. steady breeze and fine weather wind SW. Courses SE-ESE we saw a steamer bound north watch on deck. employed sawing boats sail and rose new guy. Gat: 33-45 Longitude 53-40

Remarks Saturday September the 28 1907
P.M. Calm and cloudy watch on deck employed showing boat sail and wash of the deck. end of day brake out weather
Gat: 33-35 Longitude 52-37

Remarks Sunday September the 29th 1907
P.M. light breeze and clear weather wind from south we saw a school of black fish and one steamer all sail set Gat: 33-25 Longitude 51-54
