P.M. steady breeze and clear weather Course ESE. Wind from SW. with all sail set employed Sailing boats sail. end of day Lat 3318 Longitude 4738

Remarks Tuesday October the first 1907

P.M. steady breeze and clear weather Wind from SW. Course ESE. all sail set Watch on deck employed Sailing boats sail and broke out Sago and Vinegar. end of day Lat: 3240 Longitude 4535

Remarks Wednesday October 2. cont. 1907

P.M. heavy southerly Wind hauled all the light sails. Watch on deck employed Sailing boats sails. end of day Lat: 3227 Longitude 4301

Remarks Thursday October the 3th 1907

P.M. heavy southerly Wind. and cloudy weather Chip on chert. Sail and chipping mych Water on deck. Watch on deck employed making boats sail end of day Lat: 3230 Longitude 4107

Remarks Friday October the 4th 1907

P.M. strong southerly Wind and heavy rain squall. hauled all the light sails. Watch on deck employed rove miffin top stanch sheet and gaff toped clw. line. broke out one barrel of meat flour molla. end Lat: 3230 Longitude 3915

at noon rain squall. weather clear up. at 12 clock. set all the sails. Wind from Southward employed ~~at~~ wash of the deck end of the day. Lat: 3220 Longitude 3755

P.M. light breeze Wind from South has been squall all day. end of day Lat: 3250 Longitude 3644

Remarks Monday October the 7th 1907

P.M. light breeze and clear weather Wind from SE. all sail set. employed fixing fore top back stay that part. and broke out Water. end of day. Lat: 3147 Longitude 3711

Remarks Tuesday October the 8th 1907

P.M. fresh breeze and squally weather Wind from SE. and hauled some of light sails Watch on deck employed strighting up some of whalling gear end of day Lat: 3045 Longitude 3625

Remarks Wednesday ~~October~~ October the 9th 1907

P.M. light breeze and clear weather Wind from SE. all sail set. Watch on deck employed repairing chafing gears and mate fixing blocks end of day. Lat: 3122 Longitude 3610

Remarks Thursday October the 10th 1907

P.M. light Trade and fine clear weather Close hauled all sails set. Watch on deck employed repairing chafing gears and rove ~~stanch~~ from main Clorgarneth end of the day Lat: 3155 Longitude 3604
