and rove known wheel rope and brack
out some beans end of day

P.m. fresh trade and squally weather
Close hauled all sails set. Watch on
deck employed brack out one barrel
of beef and put out from boats masts
back stay. end of day. Lat. 28.14 Longitude 331.8

P.m. fresh trade and squally weather.
Close hauled. all sails set. Lat. 26.50 Longitude 330.7

Remarks Monday October the 14th 1907

P.m. strong easterly trade. Close hauled.
hauled all the light sails. employed
brack out flour. end of day.

Lat 24.30 Longitude 31.37

Remarks Tuesday October the 15th 1907

P.m. fresh trade wind and clear
weather. Close hauled. all sails set.
Watch on deck employed brack out
bread and rove one of W. boat fall
new. and one of S. the boat fall ~~new~~
known. and sitting fore gallant rigging
and one side of fore top rigging and
rove fore low top brace new.
end of day Lat 22.45 Longitude 31.15

Remarks Wednesday October the 16th 1907

P.m. light trade wind and clear weather
Close hauled all sails set. Watch on deck
employed sitting on side of fore top rigging
and sitting fore top and gallant barch stay.
and m~~ain~~ top and gallant barch stay. and
moving B. boat fall new. and Gunge boat
of the house put it on the Crain. and saw
one steamer bound to NW. end of day.

Remarks Thursday October the 17th 1907

P.m. light trade wind and squally weather
Course SE. all sails set. Watch on deck employed
overhold fore gallant foot rope and rigger S.B.B.
boat. end of day Lat. 20.00 Longitude 29.17

P.m. light trade and clear weather
Course SE. all sails set. Watch on deck
employed overhold fore up top foot rope.
and fixing S.B. boat board and
mast. end of day Lat 18.30 Longitude 28.48

Remarks Saturday October the 19th 1907

P.m. light trade and fine clear weather
Course South. E. all sails set. Watch on
deck employed overhold foot rope. and
painting S.B.B. ing side. end of day
Lat 17.03 Longitude 28.15

Remarks Sunday October the 20th 1907

P.m. fresh trade and cloudy weather.
Course South. E. all sails set. end of day
Lat 15.20 Longitude 28.30
