

Remarks Monday October the 21 1907

P.m. Strong trade wind and cloudy weather hauled all the light sails. Watch on deck employed brack out beef rice and mollarra. and we saw one steamer end of day. sun obscure.

Remarks Tuesday October the 22 1907

P.m. light wind and squally weather with heavy rain. close hauled and all sails ~~set~~ Watch on deck employed brack out water. end of day. Sun obscure.

Remarks Wednesday October the 23 1907

P.m. fresh S.E. trade and fine clear weather all sails set & close hauled. Watch on deck employed obhold foot rope and reeving of new gib and flying gib sheet. Saw two vessel. and steamers bound north. Lat: 11.15- end of the day Longit: 27.08

Remarks Thursday October the 24 1907

P.m. light wind and squally weather with heavy rain. close hauled. all sails set. Watch on deck employed brack out flour and reeving fore topsail halyard. saw. and catching rain water fill up the casks. end of day sun obscure.

Remarks Friday October the 25th. 1907

P.m. light S.E. wind and squally weather with rain. close hauled all sails set. Watch on deck employed overhaul foot rope and brack out mollarra end of day Lat: 8.38 Longit: 25.55

Remarks Saturday October the 26th. 1907

P.m. light breeze and squally weather. Wind from southward close hauled all sails set. and watch on deck employed brack out sugar and pease. we saw several vessels and steamer bound south. and we spoke one steamer bound north. we low down the boat to put a later bord. and he gave us Longitude and changes time with us. Lat 8.05 Longit: 26.11 end of day

Remarks Sunday October the 27th 1907

P.m. light S.E. wind and clear weather all sails set we saw one vessel bound south. and we got one ropes. end of day Lat 7.40 Longit: 25.42

Remarks Monday October the 28th. 1907

P.m. light breeze and clear weather Wind from southward. close hauled all sails set. Watch on deck employed reeving foot ropes and plating snate. and saw bark on sight. Lat 6.04 Longit: 25.07

Remarks Tuesday October the 29th 1907

P.m. ~~sun~~ calm and squally weather all sails set. Watch on deck employed claiming the tools. and spreads end of day. sun obscure.

Remarks Wednesday October the 30th. 1907

A.m. calm at three P.m. light breeze with rain squall Wind from SW. all sails set and we saw school of black fish and saw bark on sight. Watch on deck employed repairing sails and making Spungam end of day Lat 4.55 Longit: 24.55
