P.m. light easterly wind and fine clear weather. Course SW. all sails set. Watch on deck employed set up main top and gallant rigging and other duty. end of day

Remarks Thursday November the 21 1907

P.m. light SE wind and fine clear weather all sails set. Course SW-W. Watch on deck employed plating surate and rove main gallant runner end of this day. Lat: 2012 Lon: 3312

Remarks Friday November the 22nd 1907

P.m. light southerly wind and fine clear weather all sails set. Course SW-W. Watch employed on ship duty. end of day. Lat: 2110 Lon: 3414

Remarks Saturday November the 23 1907

P.m. light SE wind and fine clear weather. Course SW. With yards square. handed off the fore and aft sails. Watch on deck on ship duty. end of this day. Lat: 2154 Lon: 3450 1/2

Remarks Sunday November the 24th 1907

P.m. light easterly wind and fine clear weather all sails set. Course SW-W. end of this day
Lat: 2330 Lon: 3553

Remarks Monday November the 25 1907

P.m. fresh breeze and cloudy weather at 5 P.m. wind hauled to the NW. and we braced the yards. Course SW-W. all sails set. Watch employed on ship duty. end of day

Latitude 2400 Lon: 3722

Remarks Tuesday November the 26th 1907

P.m. light SW wind and foggy weather. Close hauled. all sails set. Watch on deck employed broke out bread vinegar beans and molasses for food. and other duty. end of day. Lat: 2720 Lon: 3849

Remarks Wednesday November the 27th 1907

at 11 A.m. strong breeze from Southward and equally weather handed all the light sails at 9h30 more moderate set all the sails again at 4 P.m. Clear up the deck and pump ship end of this day. Lat: 2814 Lon: 4019

Remarks Thursday November the 28th 1907

P.m. light N.E. wind and hazy weather. Course SW. all sails set. Watch on deck on ship duty. and broke out water end of day. Lat: 3027 Long: 4152

Remarks Friday November the 29th 1907

at 1.30 A.m. wind hauled to Southward. and braced up the yards. All sails set. Course SW-W. and very hazy weather. Watch on deck employed broke out beef and other duty. Sun obscure. end of day

Remarks Saturday November the 30th 1907

at 10 A.m. wind hauled to NE. and we square the yards. handed all the fore and aft the sails. at 630 P.m. take in fore gallant sail. light breeze and cloudy weather. Watch employed on ship duty end of day
