March 30th. 1908

Remarks on board the bark bertha.

Throughout this day light breeze and rainy weather. Wind from NE. Watch employed wash off the ship out side and received a board 2 coil of line and barrel of rice 1 bot of fish 1 barrel of Palatoes end of day

Tuesday

March 31st

Throughout this day strong NE wind and clear weather. employed break out flour meat and other duty and let one watch ashore end of day

Wednesday

April 1st 1908

Throughout this day light NE wind and fine clear weather employed towing case ashore and taking a board one bot oil clothing one barrel of beans one lb. bbl. peas one lb. bbl. rice three cases from oil six boxes canned provisions one bot apples one bot prunes from the mast end of day

Thursday

April 2nd 1908

Throughout this light breeze and fine clear weather wind NE employed break out oil and one man employed from shore end of day

Friday

April 3rd 1908

Throughout this light breeze and fine clear weather wind from E. employed break out some oil one man employed from shore end of day

Saturday

April 4th 1908

Throughout this day fine weather wind from E. employed painting ironwork and other duty end of day at four pm. came in one bark and one at 6 came one schooner end of day

Remarks on board the bark bertha

April 5th 1908

Sunday

Throughout this day strong breeze and clear weather wind from E. and some of the crew went came board of the ship and one schooner river to day end of day

Monday

April 6th 1908

Throughout this day strong wind and clear weather wind from E. received board the ship half goat one man employed from shore and four of men shore three sailor and one boatstere went came board of ship and schooner bertha. d. Nipsing went out at 4 p.m. end of day

Tuesday

April 7th 1908

Throughout this day strong wind and clear weather wind from E. employed discharging oil board the three mast and broke out some oil. three of sailor deserted ship and one boatstere third mate went came the board of ship to day one man employed. and at one clock came one whaling bark to meet end of day

Wednesday

April 8th 1908

Throughout this day strong breeze and rainy weather wind from E. employed finish broke out oil and shipping some board the three mast one man employed received board some meat and veg. end of day
