April the 9th. 1908 Throughout this day light breeze and squally weather with heavy rain. employed finished discharging oil and ball put to anchor and finished taking a board beef flour pork and fisco and end of day

Friday

April the 10th 1908 Throughout this day light breeze and fine clear weather. wind from E. employed stow flour. one man employed came board some beef and veg. end of day

Saturday

April the 11th throughout this day light breeze and clear weather. wind from NE. employed stow down and making some water received a board meat and veg. end of day

Sunday

April the 12th Throughout this day light breeze and squally weather. wind from NE. at 12 clock back Alice Knobs came in. end of day

Monday

April the 13th. 1908 Throughout this day light breeze and clear weather. wind from NE. employed stow down the provision. end of day

Tuesday

April the 14th. 1908 Throughout this day steady breeze and rainy weather. wind from NE. employed making water. and painting ship came board some meat. end of day

## Remarks on board the bark Leatha

Wednesday

April the 15th. 1908 Throughout this day light breeze and squally weather. wind from NE. employed getting wood and water. and two sailor run away from the ship end of day.

Thursday

April the 16th. 1908 Throughout this day steady breeze and fine weather. wind from NE. employed making water and stow down brake out beef pork and flour. manned philips life off duty and two men employed. end of day.

Friday

April the 17th. 1908 light breeze and clear weather. wind from E. employed making water end of day.

Saturday

April the 18th. 1908 Throughout this day light breeze and fine clear weather. wind from E. employed making water. received board meat and for topmast. back stay. end of day.

Sunday

April the 19th. 1908 Throughout this day light breeze and clear weather. wind from E. end of day.

Monday

April the 20th. 1908 Throughout this day light breeze and cloudy weather. wind from E. employed making water. and two men run away. and three more off duty end of day.
