

Remarks on Tuesday June 10th 1820

These 24 hours begins with light winds and pleasant weather at 8 P.M. saw the Bay of Islands bearing S.E. took the wind at N.E. tackt ship occasionally and stood in for the Bay of Islands - so ends these 24 hours 13 days out Port

Remarks on Wednesday June 11th 1820

These 24 hours begins with light winds and pleasant weather. stood in for the land, at 4 about ship and stood off at 10 P.M. sprang up a breeze to the S.W. steering N.E. through the straits - Latter part light winds & foggy - 14 Days out Port

Remarks on Thursday June 12th 1820

These 24 hours begins with leading breezes and pleasant weather all sail set at 8 P.M. Put Saunders Bore & B.W. 5 leagues distance - steering N.E. and at 10 P.M. we were surrounded by Ice the Straights being a solid mass - backed our wind & tackt ship - Reasonably to keep clear of Ice - A number of Ships & Barges in Co. - at 2 P.M. came to Anchor in ~~Port~~ Saunders with heavy Gales - Port open Choir 16 Days out Port

Remarks on Friday June 13th 1820

This morning begins with light winds and foggy sent 2 boats a fishing - got more water & heavy gails and rain ends this day caught 113 fish - 16 days out Port

Remarks on ~~Friday~~ Saturday June 14th 1820

This morning comes in with tremendous gails and thick rainy weather, both anchors down, took on one whale boat - on deck people employed in sundry Jobs - making splashing to the Lobster net &c caught a number of Lobsters so ends the day - 17 Days out Port

Remarks on Sunday June 15th 1820

This Morning comes in with fresh Gails and clear weather at 10 A.M. have up our anchors and underput to windward under harbour Island & moved ship again, latter part heavy gails started our Anchors - still lying waiting for the Ice to clear the Straights - winds at South - 18 Days out Port

Remarks on Monday 16th June 1820

This morning comes in with fresh gails - sent one boat a fishing caught 429 fish - people on board employed in repairing the sail and other Jobs of ships duty - so ends this day with heavy gails and rainy - winds S.S.W. 19 Days out Port
