Remarks on Sunday June 29th

This morning comes in with Pleasant weather. Landed all sail to dry. sent one boat a watering, secured cables and suffeth. Middle boat. Squally we got 2 Barrels water. hauled sails. people went on shore. Occasionally returned and caught a number of fish. all boats ready to go a fishing. - angelfish arrived. so ends this day 32 days out Port.

Remarks on Monday June 30th 1820

This day begins with tremendous gales at midnight went a drift - paid out all both of cables, and clinched the ends to the mast - still a drifting at last trot up - all hands employed in heaving clear of Ice, the Ice coming in in abundance - trying to keep it off trying to keep clear with our ears. 38 fath by showing the vessel.

Middle boat more moderate - sent one boat a fishing - returned caught 100 fish - unmoored ship and moved her again. The Ice coming in again in abundance hove up our Anchors and went into of W Cove in company with Capt Low moored ship and suffeth - so ends the day with thick weather 33 days out Port.

Remarks on Tuesday July 1st 1820

This morning comes in with fresh breeze and foggy - got out our Out riggers and other sails preparing for fishing - caught a number of fish repaired one boat which got damaged by Ice - got some Capelin this day which is the first that has been caught so ends the day 34 Days out Port.

Remarks on Wednesday July 2d 1820.

This morning comes in with light winds - and plenty of Ice 2 boats went a fishing and one after boat so ends the day Caught 1070 fish 35 days out Port.

Remarks on Thursday July 3d 1820

This morning comes in with fresh breeze and raining all hands employed in wooding and watering. got no capelin this day nor fish so ends the day 36 days out Port. Caught 1122 fish.

Remarks on Friday July 4th 1820

This morning comes in with thick cloudy weather all hands employed in fishing - Caught 1129 fish - so ends the day - 37 Days out Port land.

Remarks on Saturday July 5th 1820

This morning comes in with glass rising weather all hands a fishing - caught 1530 fish - so ends the day - 38 days from Puttland.
