

Remarks on Friday July 18th 1880

This morning comes in with thick rainy weather all boats a fishing - caught 11487 fish - ends the day with thick rainy weather 51 Days from Portland

Remarks on Saturday July 19th 1880

This morning comes in with thick rainy weather all boats a fishing - caught 11487 fish - ends the day with thick rainy weather 52 Days from Portland

Remarks on Sunday July 20th 1880

This morning begins with thick foggy weather - boats all sail to dry - and sundry other lots of ships duty to ends the day 53 days from Portland

Remarks on Monday July 21st 1880

This morning comes in with pleasant weather - all boats a fishing caught 2256 fish 54 days from Portland one man sick

Remarks on Tuesday July 22nd 1880

This morning comes in with light winds and pleasant weather all boats a fishing caught 1176 fish - one man sick 55 days out Port

Remarks on Wednesday July 23rd 1880

This day begins with pleasant weather 2 boats a fishing caught 1822 fish 56 days out

Remarks on Thursday July 24th 1880

This morning comes in with moderate weather - all boats a fishing - one man sick and caught 1900 fish 57 Days from Portland

Remarks on Friday July 25th 1880

This morning begins with easterly wind and pleasant weather all boats a fishing caught 1289 fish - ends the day 58 days out Portland

Remarks on Saturday July 26th 1880

This morning begins with thick rainy weather with strong winds of wind sent 2 boats a fishing - one boat in the breakers - lost some lines and shipwrecked boats rode and a number of articles - landed out the boat and loaded her on board again - filled three barrels water - ends this day 59 days out Portland

Remarks on Sunday July 27th 1880

This morning comes in with pleasant weather - all boats a fishing - one man sick - ends the day 60 days from Portland

Remarks on Monday July 28th 1880

This morning comes in with fresh breeze and rainy weather caught 2737 fish 61 days from Portland

Remarks on Tuesday July 29th 1880

This morning begins with thick rainy weather and heavy gales from the North - latter part heavy rain from the West - attended with heavy rain - boats stop from fishing - caught 700 fish - 62 days from Portland

Remarks on Wednesday July 30th 1880

This morning begins with good weather - all boats a fishing caught 881 fish - latter part light winds - 63 days from Portland
