

Ship Herald of Parkhaven on a whaling Voyage to the S Atlantic

Wednesday 14th December
 Commenced with fresh winds from the S.W. saw few backs at dark took in sail for the night middle part - fresh winds and squalls latter part - squally

Thursday 15th
 Commenced with fresh winds and squally weather at dark moderate short tacked sail middle part - calm at 5 PM a light wind from the S.W. set all sail steering S by W

Friday 16th
 Commenced with fresh winds and cloudy weather at dark took in sail middle part - light winds and fine weather at 5 saw few backs latter part - all sail set steering S E

Saturday 17th
 Commenced with light winds from the S.W. and squally weather saw few backs at dark double reefed the topsails middle part - light winds at 4 set all sail saw few backs once with fine weather

Sunday 18th
 Commenced with gentle winds from the S.W. saw few backs at dark took in sail middle part - moderate at 4 a fresh breeze set all sail saw few backs at 11 PM wind increasing smooth reefed topsails

Monday 19th
 The first part - fresh winds from the S.W. double reefed the topsails wind increasing shortened sail as required middle part - strong gales at 7 took in the fore sail at 10 took in the main topsail

Tuesday 20th
 Began with heavy gales from S.W. middle part - more moderate at 7 set out the foresail latter part - moderate set fore topsail and sprain sail

Wednesday 14th December
 Began with gentle winds from S.W. and at heavy squalls at dark double reefed the topsails middle part - strong winds and squalls latter part - saw few backs

Thursday 15th
 Began with strong winds and rough sea at 7 more ship of the S.E. middle part - squally took in the main sail and mizen topsail latter part - fresh winds from S.W.

Friday 16th
 Began with fresh winds from S.W. set the mizen topsail middle part - light winds at 4 at 7 set all sail latter part - calm and cloudy

Saturday 17th
 Began with light airs and cloudy weather saw few backs at dark shortened sail for the night - middle part - light airs and calms at 4 a breeze from S.E. set all sail latter part - fresh winds and rain double reefed the topsails steering S by W

Sunday 18th
 Commenced with strong winds from S.E. and rain at dark took in sail middle part - fresh winds at 4 made sail saw few backs latter part - wind S.W.

Monday 19th
 Commenced with light winds from the S.W. and squally weather saw a few backs at dark close reefed the topsails middle part - fresh winds at 4 made sail at 5 spoke the foremast Parthian of New Bedford 60 tons off from Captain Adams came on board double reefed the topsails at 11 Capt Adams returned to his vessel

Tuesday 20th
 Commenced with strong winds from S.W. the ship under close reefed topsails steering S by W middle part - strong winds at 4 more moderate made sail saw a right whale going quick gulls with fine weather and light winds
