Sunday 15th January

Commenced with fresh winds from SSW at 3 sounded 80 fathoms at 4 set the fore and mizen topsails and mizen sail at 5 raised the reef on middle part light winds and fine weather at 6 calm latter part light airs caught some fish 55 fathoms

Monday 16th

Began with light winds from NNE and pleasant weather at 7 saw a whale could not ascertain of what kind middle part fresh winds from the N latter part wind hauled to the NE

Tuesday 17th

Began with light winds from SSW and fine weather at 4 calm middle part brisk breezes and cloudy latter part strong gales took in sail and have been employed in making out the after hold

Wednesday 18th

Commenced with fresh winds and clear weather at 4 more moderate set the fore topsail and main sail middle part light winds and clear at 4 set all sail latter part wind from the N employed in scraping ship

Thursday 19th

Began with gentle winds from the N at 4 reaching at 5 took in sail and have set middle part strong gales from the W set the fore sail latter part no alteration

Friday 20th

Strong gales and clear at 10 more ship to the NW middle part much the same latter part moderate

Saturday 21st

Commenced with fresh winds from the SSW at 1 PM set the fore and mizen top sails at 3 took in sail for the night middle part moderate at 4 set all sail at 11 squally took in sail and have too

Began with fresh winds from the NW saw a shoal of blackfish lowered the boats could not get lost at 8 moderate winds and fine weather made sail at dark close reefed the fore and main topsails middle part light airs at 5 made sail latter part fresh winds and fine weather steering NW 55 fathoms

Monday 23rd

Light winds from the SSW and very fine weather at 8 took in sail for the night middle part light winds at 5 made sail latter part fresh winds from the SSW at 10 more ship

Tuesday 24th

Commenced with light winds from the SSW and fine weather at 1 PM saw the land, Cape San Blas bearing W by N 20 miles at dark took in sail middle part strong gales at 7 more ship and set the fore sail latter part more moderate set the topsails the land still in sight

Wednesday 25th

Commenced with fresh winds from the SSW at 4 PM took in sail and have too at 5 furled the fore sail middle part strong gales from the S at 4 inclined to moderate at 5 made sail latter part heavy squalls took in sail

Thursday 26th

Commenced with strong winds from the S at 1 PM set the fore topsail at dark have too middle part wind fresh and cloudy weather latter part light airs from the S
