Thursday 9th February
Commences with fresh winds
from the NW at 3 PM saw 2 whales
lowered the light could not get
fast at 7 took in sail middle part
wind light at 8 shifted to the S at 4:30
made sail at 7 squally double reefed
the topsails at 10 took in sail and hove too

Friday 10th
Lat- Begins with strong gales from the
45° 50' S at 6 inclined to moderate
Long- middle part squally at 8 made sail
64° 00' W wind increasing double reefed
the topsails latter part more moder-
ate

Saturday 11th
Lat- Begins with light winds and plea-
sant weather at 1 PM turned the
45° 39' S reefed out the topsails at 7 took in
Long- sail middle part light winds and
63° 03' W cloudy latter part calm employed
in mending sails

Sunday 12th
Lat- Commences with light winds
46° 00' S from the NW at 5 saw fin backs
Long- 64° 34' W middle part light winds latter part
154 fresh breezes from the N course ESE

Monday 13th
Lat- Begins with fresh winds from the
46° 00' S and clear weather at 3 PM double
Long- reefed the topsails saw fin backs
64° 35' W middle part strong gales and cloudy
154 at 5 set the fore topsail saw fin backs

Tuesday 14th
Lat- Commences with fresh winds
45° 40' S from the NW at 2 inclined to
Long- moderate turned the reefs out
63° 05' W set the mainsail and hove at dark
106 double reefed the topsails middle part
high winds at 4 made sail latter
part fresh winds from the E

Wednesday 15th
Lat- Begins with fresh winds from the
45° 30' S East at 4 PM saw whales lowered could
Long- not get fast at 6 lowered again with no
63° 11' W better success middle part strong gales and
154 cloudy at 7 set the fore and main topsails
latter part light winds and pleasant

coast of Patagonia. whaling Ship 31

Thursday 16th February
Lat- Commences with light winds from
45° 34' S the NW all sail set at 7 double reefed
Long- the topsails at 10 furlled the fore and
62° 37' W main topsails middle part moderate
188 at 4 set all necessary sail latter
part fresh winds and hazy double
reefed the topsails

Friday 17th
Lat- Commences with strong winds
45° 00' S from the NW at 3 PM spoke Ship
Long- Margaret of New York 2 whales
63° 39' W at dark took in sail for the night
190 middle part strong gales at 4:30 set
the topsails double reefed latter part
wind and weather much the same
Margaret employed in taking in salt water

Saturday 18th
Lat- Begins with fresh gales from the
45° 00' S at dark chose reefed the topsails
Long- middle part moderate at 4 made
64° 18' W sail latter part light winds from
194 the E steering SSE

Sunday 19th
Lat- Begins with light winds from the
45° 04' S at 4 PM unhooked the fore topsail
Long- and bent another at dark reefed
64° 26' W the topsails middle part light winds
194 latter part calm and pleasant

Monday 20th
Lat- Commences with light winds
46° 49' S from the NW at 7 set whole main
Long- middle part light winds and clear
63° 50' W at 7 a breeze from the NE latter
192 part gentle winds and pleasant

Tuesday 21st
Lat- Begins with fresh breezes
45° 50' S from the ENE employed in
Long- repairing the fore topsail middle
61° 54' W part moderate at 7 fresh winds
193 latter part wind hauled to the NW
double reefed the topsails course SE
