

Ship Herald of Fair Haven

Tuesday 28th March
 Lat 41° 40' Commenced with light winds and fine weather at 6 double reefed the
 Long top sails middle part calm at 6 a
 1800 light breeze from the South set all
 228 light breeze from the South set all
 228 fine pleasant weather 3 sail in sight

Wednesday 29th March
 Lat 41° 40' Begins with light winds from the South at 4 AM spoke Ship Delphos
 229 a more sail in sight at dark double reefed the top sails middle part wind
 229 light at 6 made sail at 8 spoke the Delphos and got 6 casks of bread
 229 saw a whale could not catch him

Thursday 30th
 Lat 41° 40' Commenced with light air and fine weather at dark shortened sail for the night at 6 made sail
 230 light breeze from the South at 10 lowered for a light whale could not get fast 15 fathoms

Friday 31st
 Lat 42° 45' Begins with light winds and rain at 4 AM took in the main top of sail
 231 at 4 AM and raising took in sail and gave too at 6 spoke the Delphos middle part moderate
 231 at 6 made sail at 8 saw a whale

Saturday 1st April
 Lat 43° 13' Commenced with light winds from the NE at 4 AM spoke Ship Heroine
 232 fresh winds and clouds at 6 made sail later part wind fresh from NE
 232 lowered for a whale could not get fast

Sunday 2nd
 Lat 43° 00' Begins with fresh winds and clouds saw whales but very wild at 6 spoke Ship Nahahy
 233 Church of Lynn 150 lbs made light wind and weather much the same at 6 made sail
 233 later part wind increased double reefed the top sails

Monday 3rd April

Lat 43° 10' Commenced with fresh winds from the NE at 8 AM took in sail and gave
 234 NW later part strong gales from the NW later part no alteration

Tuesday 4th
 Lat 43° 08' Begins with heavy gales from the NW at 9 AM spoke Ship Heroine
 235 moderate at 6 made sail later part fresh winds and fine weather one
 235 sail in sight saw fin backs 50 fathoms

Wednesday 5th
 Lat 43° 27' Commenced with fresh winds and pleasant weather at 8 AM spoke Ship Heroine of Hagar 10 lbs sperm
 236 at 6 took in sail for the night 50 fathoms middle part strong winds and clouds at 6 set the top sails double reefed a Barge on the deck
 236 at 8 a heavy squall from the NW took in all sail at 10 set the main top sail and fore sail

Thursday 6th
 Lat 43° 28' Begins with squalls and rain middle part strong winds from the South at 6 more moderate set the top sails fished ship plow saw fin backs at 11 AM a heavy squall from the NW took in all sail

Friday 7th
 Lat 43° 10' Begins with fresh gales and cloudy weather at 4 AM set the main top sail at 4 PM spoke Ship Heroine
 237 Hadding of Fair Haven 160 lbs middle part strong winds and squally at 6 set the top sails later part squally double reefed the top sails

Saturday 8th
 Lat 43° 10' Begins with fresh winds from the NE at 4 AM spoke Ship Heroine
 238 Captain He came on board at 4 PM took in sail and gave 100 lbs
 238 Captain He returned to his ship middle part moderate at 6 set all sail later part light winds and fine weather two sail in sight
