Commenced with light air and variable at 4 PM a breeze from the N. at 6 took in sail for the night. Ship heading to the N. and made sail at 9 AM chased a whale
Lat 38° 52'

284 Monday 22nd
Began with fresh winds from NE at 4 PM were ship to NE at dark took in sail heading NE mid fresh winds from NE latter part wind light and cloudy weather

Commenced with light winds from the N and cloudy weather at 5 took in sail heading E by N 58 fathoms at 7 PM and calmed mid part light winds made sail heading E latter part strong winds from S by W ship under double reefed topsails

Commenced with fresh gales from S by W and clear weather at dark took in sail for the night mid part moderate at 7 made sail and more ship latter part wind light and sail in sight

Commenced with light winds from W and fine weather at 4 PM were ship to the S at dark shortened sail for the night heading S mid part calm at 7 made sail at 8 thick latter part light winds from NE

289 Saturday 27th
Began with light winds from NE and fine weather at 4 PM lowered for a whale could not get past at dark shortened sail for the night course E by N mid part moderate moderate at 7 made sail latter part wind and weather much the same
Lat 38° 57' Long 66° 02' W

290 Sunday 28th
Commenced with light winds from NE and good weather at 4 PM a light breeze course S by E at dark double reefed the topsails mid part light winds and thick latter part wind E by S saw fin backs three sail in sight

291 Monday 29th
Began with fresh winds from E passed Barque Royal at 4 PM spoke ship Nantux Lynn 1000 tons at 6 took in sail heading S by W mid part strong gales and thick weather at 8 more ship to the E latter part wind and weather No Obs

292 Tuesday 30th
Commenced with fresh gales from S furled the fore sail mid part more moderate at 7 made sail latter part fresh winds and cloudy double reefed the topsails
