

813 Tuesday 20th June
Begins with fresh winds, and pleasant weather at 2 P.M. inclined to moderate sea, the topsails and sails middle and lower part of sails

Lat 24° 53' S Long 42° 23' W

814 Wednesday 21st
First part, calm at 4 P.M. a light breeze from S. E. in the night, the main topsail and fore part of the middle part, wind hauled off at 9 saw the land bearing off by 80 miles distant, latter part, light winds and fine weather

Lat 25° 59' Long 48° 00'

815 Thursday 22nd
Begins with light winds and pleasant weather at 3 P.M. saw a large ship (E) at 11, hauled to the middle part, light winds from N. W. saw the light at the entrance of Rio at daylight, close in with the land at 1 P.M. arrived at anchor, the anchor in the harbour of Rio Janeiro at 2 P.M. the Capt. went on shore at 8 light winds and cloudy

816 Friday 23rd
Commenced with light air from S. at 8 A.M. the star board watch went on shore on liber by the fresh winds from S. at 8 men returned on board

Only 10th sailed from Rio for the Grande arrived 10th and sailed

250 lbs whale 150 sperm

Thursday August 2nd 1837

817 Commenced with fresh winds and rainy weather at 8 calm at 10 a breeze from S.W. and pleasant air, got under weigh and proceeded to sea at 6 calm middle part, light air and hailing at 7 wind E latter part, fresh winds and fine weather all hands employed in securing anchors stowing cables

818 Friday 4th
Begins with fresh winds from E at 9 doubled reefed the topsails and furled the jib at 10 in the main sail at 10 the fore topsail middle part, fresh gale and heavy sea close reefed the main topsail latter part, more moderate sea the fore topsail Lat 25° 30' S

819 Saturday 5th August
First part, fresh winds from E and a short swell. Middle part, more moderate at 6 made sail latter part, fresh winds and squally at 10 reefed the topsails Lat 26° 39' S

820 Monday 7th
Commenced with fresh winds and rain at 2 P.M. the top sail is blowing very hard from S.W. the main topsail at 4 more moderate sea the fore sail and main topsail at 6 fresh winds and fine weather latter part, the same

Lat 26° 12' S Long 40° 38' W
